1. Decennial Jubilee Year Celebration:

Various programs and competitions were conducted by the alumni, departments, and committees to celebrate the Decennial Jubilee Year.

2. UGC Recognition:

The college received a 2f certificate from UGC.

3. Preparation of Academic Calendar 2021-22:

A meeting of HoDs and coordinators of various committees was held on 01/04/2021 to finalize activities for the next academic year and prepare the academic calendar 2021-22.

4. IQAC Proposal to the Principal for Installation of Solar Panels:

A solar panel installation with 42 kW was accomplished in the college campus at the proposal of IQAC to support various college activities.

5. Inauguration of Integrated Coaching:

Integrated coaching services were introduced in the college to enhance students' performance and bring about lasting changes. The program is designed to motivate and encourage students through a leadership program.

6. Boundary Wall:

A boundary wall around the campus has been constructed to provide security and protection to students, staff, and the college's green environment.

7. Workshop on IPR:

Students and teachers were made aware of various aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).

8. Newly Joined Staff Orientation:

An orientation program was organized to introduce newly appointed professors to their new workplace and provide background information about the college. Effective orientation was provided to inform them of the college's policies and expectations.
