

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between

St. Xavier's College, Mahuadanr

And

Carmel Hospital, Mahuadanr

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU") is executed between St. Xavier's College, Mahuadanr (hereinafter referred to as "SXCM"), a college with an address at Mahuadanr, Latehar-822119, Jharkhand, including its lawful representatives and permitted assigns; and Carmel Hospital, Mahuadanr, a Registered hospital with an address at Mahuadanr, Latehar-822119, Jharkhand, including its lawful representatives and permitted assigns (hereinafter referred to singularly as "The Party" and collectively as "The Parties").

WHEREAS

- A. SXCM is an established college with a proven track record of educational excellence and research. It has successfully developed dynamic collaborative arrangements with various institutions including colleges, schools, hospitals, and industries.
- B. Carmel Hospital is an established and reputable healthcare facility that is committed to meeting the medical needs of the local people. It provides timely care and services to different nearby villages.
- C. The parties are eager to enter into this MoU to express their respective intentions and establish a foundation for cooperation and collaboration. The terms and conditions of this MoU are outlined herein.

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:


OBJECTIVE

The Parties, in accordance with the terms of this MoU applicable at each party's respective jurisdiction, shall strive to enhance, promote, and develop outreach programs. They shall provide internships to students and cooperate with each other on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

AREAS OF COOPERATION

The Parties agree to actively encourage the following activities, specifically aimed at promoting academic cooperation in the following areas:

- a) Facilitating institutional exchanges between faculty and staff members from each partner institution.

- b) Welcoming undergraduate students from SXCM for internships and field trips.
- c) Organizing health-related programs both within the College and in nearby villages.
- d) Exchanging information regarding developments and advancements.
- e) Cooperating in any other areas as agreed upon by the Parties periodically.
- f) Mutually promoting information and activities of the partner institutions within the scope of this MoU.

ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION


- This MoU shall become effective as of the date of the signatures of both parties. If the dates of the signatures vary, then the effective date shall be the date of the later signature.
- This MoU shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years.
- This MoU may be extended for any further period as agreed upon in writing by both parties.
- If the MoU is not renewed by mutual consent, it shall conclude at the end of the specified period or after the completion of ongoing activities.

REVISION, VARIATION AND AMENDMENT

- i. Either party may request in writing a revision, variation, or amendment of this MoU, subject to the approval of the other party.
- ii. Any revision, variation, or amendment agreed upon by the Parties shall be documented in writing and shall be considered a part of this MoU.
- iii. The revised, varied, or amended terms shall come into force on a date determined by the Parties.
- iv. The implementation of any project, activity, or cooperation based on this MoU prior to or up to the date of any revision, variation, or amendment shall not be affected or prejudiced.

TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a written notice of at least ninety (90) days to the other party. In the event of termination, ongoing activities at the time of termination shall be allowed to conclude as originally planned, unless both parties agree otherwise.



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
FOR ACADEMIC AND SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION**

This MOU is made on the 21st day of the month of January 2019.

Between

And

**Sr. Rosella, the Administrator of
Carmel Hospital, Mahuadanr, Latehar Dist. Jharkhand**

Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to promote higher education and practical experiences between St. Xavier's College, Mahuadanr (SXCM) and Carmel Hospital, Mahuadanr (CHM), Dist. Latehar Jharkhand.

Types of Cooperation

Through this memorandum, both Parties establish the value of collaboration and agree to promote the following activities:

1. Projects and field works in the area of mutual interest;
2. Exchange of academic publications and reports;
3. Opportunities for faculty and staff development and exchange programs;
4. Exchange of visiting staffs and students;
5. Other activities as mutually agreed.

Consideration:

This Agreement places no financial consideration or funding commitments on either party. The aforementioned activities will be defined through separate program agreements and subsequent program agreements must be approved in writing by the authorized representatives of each institution.

Assistant Professor Ravi Roshan Minz of the Department of History of SXCM will serve as the primary liaison between the two institutions to facilitate the development of future activities.

Terms and Conditions:

The duration of this Agreement will remain valid for a period of five (5) years and become effective upon the date of signature by both Parties. Amendments can be made by the mutual consent of both Parties. This Agreement may be terminated by either Party with advance written notice of at least thirty (30) days. Upon notice of termination both parties agree to work in good faith to enable visiting students to complete their respective projects unopposed by the termination. The agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two Parties after the five-year period, and it must be renewed in writing.

This Memorandum of Understanding completed in English is hereby signed in two (2) copies by both parties on the 21st day of the month of January 2019 with one (1) copy each remaining in the possession of each institution.




